## The WRPC has a variety of ranges and events:

### RANGES:

- Upper Bay
  - Bay 1: 50 ft pistol
  - Bay 2 & 3: 50 ft pistol (closed except for scheduled events)
  - Bay 4: 200 yd rifle
    - All calibers EXCEPT 50 cal Browning or full automatic
- Middle Bay
  - Bay 5: up to 100 yards for pistol and rimfire
- Lower Bays
  - Bays 6, 7, 8, 9: pistol, rimfire and shotguns
- Indoor
  - Five bays for 50 ft pistol and rimfire (no pistol magnums)

Outdoor ranges are open from 8 AM until dusk

Indoor ranges are open 24 hours.

**General and Safety Rules**

- 1) Alcoholic beverages are never allowed on club property.
- 2) No 50 caliber Browning cartridge firearms are allowed on club property.
- 3) No hunting is ever allowed on club property.
- 4) Uncased loaded firearms are allowed only on the firing line.
- 5) ALL uncased firearms will have actions open and a chamber indicator in place.
- 6) Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
- 7) All bullets must impact the designated area.
- 8) Always be aware of your target and the back stop.
- 9) Glass and rock targets are forbidden.
- 10) Know your firearms and their capabilities.
- 11) Treat every firearm as if it is loaded.
- 12) No one under the age of eighteen (18) may handle firearms without adult supervision.
- 13) Hearing and eye protection is recommended while on Club property, and required when shooting at hard surfaced items such as steel plates. Hearing and eye protection may be made mandatory during a match by the Match Director.
- 14) Hard surfaced targets may be shot only on designated areas of the range.
- 15) Centerfire high power rifle rounds are only allowed on Bay 4.
- 16) Bump stocks are prohibited on club property.
- 17) The hosting member is responsible for the actions of their guest(s) and may be charged for any damages that occur.
- 18) Only .17 & .22 caliber rimfire, and handgun calibers with moderate loaded bullets are allowed on the indoor range. All bullets will impact the backstop no higher than 42" above the floor.
- 19) No one is allowed behind or beside the indoor range when in use. No one is to be on the berms or in the woods when the outdoor ranges are in use.
- 20) Steel can only be shot on the indoor range during sanctioned matches supervised by a Range Officer.
- 21) The last person to leave the indoor range should ensure that all brass is picked up, targets removed, lights and heat turned off, doors and windows locked.
- 22) All ranges are open subject to the restrictions noted in the range and clubhouse rules.
- 23) The use of automatic firearms is subject to the approval of the Executive Officer.
- 24) Night vision/night shoots are subject to the approval of the Executive Officer.
- 25) All facilities, including targets and framework, are for the use of all members unless otherwise marked.
- 26) Targets should be mounted on frames so that bullets will not damage the frame work.
- 27) All activities except personal target practice must be scheduled at a membership meeting prior to the event. Scheduled events always take precedents over personal activities.
- 28) Members will not wait more than one hour to use club facilities after notifying the person using the range of their desire to use the range.
- 29) All members must have their membership card with them when using club facilities. They must produce the card whenever asked for identification by another member.

- 30) All members must sign in and out at the gate when using club facilities. This is not required while attending sanctioned matches or monthly meetings.
- 31) The gate combination will be changed every April and will be communicated to members when the annual membership cards are distributed. The gate combination will not be shared with non-members.
- 32) Members must close and lock the gate both when arriving and leaving club property.
- 33) Club members with RO certification for club approved activities may hold unscheduled practice which follow rules per the respective activity. Members must have proof of RO certification with them during the unscheduled practice. Additional participants are permitted at the practice session while under RO supervision. Club guest policies still apply. No exceptions to targets placed at the backstop on the indoor range.

### **Rules for Bow and Arrow**

- 1) All club rules must be followed
- 2) Member must bring his/her own targets and backstop
- 3) Arrows may be shot on the indoor range, or any of the outdoor ranges
